**DEBRIS REMOVAL HAS BEGUN BY THE COH:**

Houston based crew is staged in the Riverview cul-de-sac, Goal for today is to get the MAIN AND ENTRY streets clear; working Riverview west of Lakeside Estates Dr., north to Big Hollow to clear main streets and will work from there. Field supervisor asks for our patience as traffic may be stopped to maneuver equipment; he assures us that every effort will be made to work efficiently and with care. Larger equipment will remove larger debris, then the smaller equipment will remove smaller debris; PLEASE MOVE ALL TRAFFIC BARRIERS SO THE CLEAN UP CREW MAY WORK CLEANLY & EFFICIENTLY- they will make every effort to access the debris, but cannot move obstacles in their way. Please spread the word, especially to your displaced neighbors & those that may not have access to the computer.

**DEBRIS REMOVAL BY THE CITY OF HOUSTON ET AL. HAS BEEN CONFIRMED; CALL OR EMAIL 311**

State Rep. Jim Murphy stated at the Town Hall meeting tonight that TXDOT will help the COH with debris removal; Murphy stated that they are aware that the debris is not only a nuisance but a "health hazard".

Alyce Coffey with COH Solid Waste stated that there will be at least three passes through the neighborhood. If you do not have your debris separated right now, don't worry about it", please do follow the guidelines as you clear more debris out. One home fills up 1- 1 1/2 trailers. This is a slow process and they are unable to provide a schedule because they do not know how quickly they can move through the neighborhood.

Greg Travis stated that "if you live in Houston, live on a public street and pay taxes, your debris will be picked up."

**ADDED SECURITY:**

**HFD: From your local firefighters, Station 69:**

Please, if you are starting to do work to your homes, please cover your smoke detectors. We are responding to a very high volume of smoke detector calls. Our fire trucks cannot make these turns and will not have a way to come help you if we can't get there. **PLEASE LET ALL YOUR NEIGHBORS KNOW.**

A request has been made (9/7/2017) to the City of Houston for Heavy Trash pick up for Lakeside Forest. They ask for a ten day window. If you would like to arrange for Texas Pride to pick up your Harvey Waste at cost to you, please contact [Texas Pride](#) directly for rates and service. **Either option for Harvey waste pick up require the streets to be navigable. PLEASE DO NOT HAVE PODS, DUMPSTERS or TRAILERS placed in the street! Please keep this in mind when you park your vehicles as well.** Please click on the yellow banner above to view a diagram for waste placement. Your waste must be placed along the curb for pick-up. The heavy trash "claw truck" must be able to reach the rubbish to heave it into the truck.
